On April 5, the government notified the Court that it was waiving its right to respond. On April 7 the case was distributed for the conference of April 23, before the April 30 due date for amici briefs.


The National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers has obtained consent from the government and petitioner to file an amicus brief in support of the petition. So that amicus may complete and timely
