Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Respondent Western Digital Corporation respectfully requests a twenty-two day extension of time to and including May 28, 2021 to file a brief in opposition to the above-referenced Petition for a Writ of Certiorari. No previous extensions have been requested, and Petitioner does not oppose this request.

On April 2, 2021, Petitioner filed his Petition for Writ of Certiorari. The Petition was docketed on April 6, 2021. There is good cause for the requested extension because the Petition raises a significant number of legal issues that Respondent expects to address in its brief in opposition to the Petition, as well as a number of factual issues and record references that Respondent must address and, in some cases, correct pursuant to Sup. Ct. R. 15.2.

We also note that Petitioner made use of the additional sixty days allotted by this Court in its March 19, 2020 order responding to COVID-19 and filed his brief 150 days after his Petition for Rehearing was denied by the circuit court.

Pursuant to Sup. Ct. R. 29.6, Respondent Western Digital Corporation states that there is no parent or publicly held company owning 10% or more of its stock.
