I am counsel for respondents Superintendent Linda A. Lacewell and the New York State Department of Financial Services in this case. I write to request an extension of time to oppose the petition for a writ of certiorari in this matter. The current deadline is June 28, 2021, and respondents Lacewell and the New York State Department of Financial Services respectfully seek an extension to August 23, 2021.
