**Re:** Request for Extension of Time to File Response to Petition in Caniglia v. Strom, No. 20-157

Dear Mr. Harris,

I am counsel for all respondents in this case, and a member of the Supreme Court bar. Petitioner filed his petition for a writ of certiorari on August 10, 2020 and the matter was docketed on August 13, 2020. According to the online docket and pursuant to Rule 15.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, a response is currently due on September 14, 2020. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, respondents respectfully request that the time for filing a response be extended by thirty (30) days, up to and including October 14, 2020.

This is respondents' first request for an extension to file a response. Good cause exists for the requested extension, in that one of the key authors of the briefs in both the District Court and First Circuit has left the firm, and new counsel needs more time to become familiar with the case. Further, the undersigned counsel has just been scheduled to present the first three jury trials in the United States District Court for the District of Rhode Island Post-Covid and will need additional time to attend to these matters. Finally, as respondents are municipal officials, any response will need to be reviewed by municipal decision makers before filing.

Accordingly, respondents respectfully request that the time for filing a response to the petition for writ of certiorari be extended by 30 days, up to and including October 14, 2020. Counsel for the petitioner has been contacted and has informed the undersigned that they have no objection to this request.
