I am counsel for respondent in the above-referenced case. On May 12, 2021, a petition for a writ of certiorari was docketed in this case. Unless extended by the Court, the response would be due on June 11, 2021. For the reasons that follow, and pursuant to Rule 30.4, I respectfully request an extension of 30 days, to and including Monday, July 12, 2021. (The requested extension encompasses 31 calendar days because the 30th day falls on a Sunday.)

I was first retained in this case to prepare the brief in opposition after the petition was filed, and I require time to familiarize myself with the case. In addition, I have and have had a number of pressing obligations during the standard response period, including among other things the need to prepare a reply in support of a petition for certiorari in this Court, to prepare for and participate in an evidentiary hearing in federal district court, to prepare and file an amicus brief in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit, to prepare a merits brief in the D.C. Circuit, and to prepare comments on a regulatory proposal by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. An extension will allow me to meet these obligations while filing a response that adequately addresses the points raised in the petition. The extension will not affect the timing of the Court's consideration of the petition.
