The Warden respectfully requests an extension of 20 days to file its brief in opposition to the petition for writ of certiorari. Counsel is currently working on an answer to a writ for petition for habeas corpus, the deadline for which was already extended to the end of June. Counsel spent a substantial amount of time preparing for an oral argument that the Kentucky Supreme Court heard yesterday. And the supervising attorney who will review a draft of the brief will be out of the office for a week in late June. Counsel needs the additional time to complete the brief in opposition.

The Warden's brief in opposition is due July 1, 2021. The 20-day extension would make it due Wednesday, July 21, 2021.
