
This office represents Respondent Mariposa County, California (“Respondent”). Respondent requests an extension of time to respond to the petition for a writ of certiorari that was filed on August 14, 2020. We request an additional 30 days after the court mandated deadline of September 18, 2020.

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Respondent requests an additional thirty-day extension to respond to Petitioner’s petition for a writ of certiorari.
