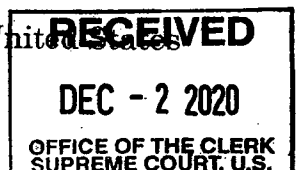

MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO FILE A RESPONSE


Dear Mr. Harris,

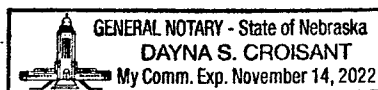
