Respondents write to request an additional 30-day extension of time to file a brief in opposition to the petition for writ of certiorari in *William P. Barr, Attorney General, et al., v. Esteban Aleman Gonzalez, et al.*, No. 20-322. Specifically, Respondents seek to extend their response time from December 14, 2020, to January 13, 2021. Respondents seek this extension in light of counsel's substantial obligations, including filing the brief in opposition this week to the petition for certiorari in *ICE v. Padilla*, No. 20-234. Respondents' obligations are further complicated by the current public health emergency related to COVID-19, which has forced the closure of each of the offices where Respondents' counsel normally work. In addition, the pandemic has forced closures of schools, camps, and child care facilities, which requires Respondents' counsel to care for minor children during this time.

Petitioners through counsel have indicated they object to the proposed extension.
