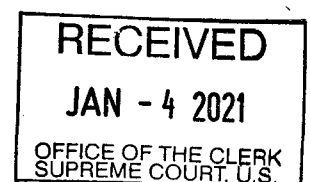

Counsel for Appellant did not respond to an inquiry as to whether they objected to this request.


