MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Pursuant to Rule 39, Rules of the Supreme Court, Petitioner Daniel Lee hereby moves for leave to proceed in forma pauperis in the above-captioned action on the ground that he lacks sufficient funds to pay for fees and expenses. arises. Accordingly, Mr. Lee asks that he be permitted to proceed *in forma pauperis* in this Court.
