Appellee's motion to dismiss the appeal in light of the valid appeal waiver (Docket Entry No. 16) is granted. *See United States v. Harris*, 628 F.3d 1203, 1205 (9th Cir. 2011) (knowing and voluntary appeal waiver whose language encompasses the right to appeal on the grounds raised is enforceable). Contrary to appellant's contention, the record shows that there was an adequate factual basis for his guilty plea and that his plea was knowing and voluntary.
