The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on July 10, 2020. The government's response was due, after one extension, on October 21, 2020. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including November 30, 2020, within which to file a response.

This extension is necessary because the attorneys with principal responsibility for preparation of the government's response have been heavily engaged with the press of previously assigned matters with proximate due dates.
