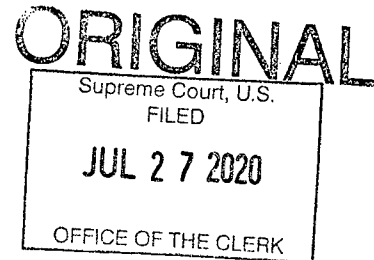

DISTRICT COURT CITED CURABLE DEFECTS IN PRO-SE 2254 HABEAS IS TIME BARRED AND ORDERED DISMISSAL, FAILING TO LIBERALLY CONSTRUCT HABEAS OR ALLOW FAIR AMENDMENT OPPORTUNITY.

DELOUITA V. ANGELONE (330 F.3D 630, 633 (4TH CIR. 2003) COURT LIBERALLY CONSTRUED PRO-SE COMPLAINT.

PETITIONER'S CUSTODIAN FAILED TO PROVIDE A LAIIN LIBRARY OR PARA-LEGAL TO ASSIST HIM IN PREPARING HIS 2254 HABEAS.

PETITIONER CLAIMED ACTUAL INNOCENCE AND COURT FAILED TO OFFER HIM TOLLING.

HAINES V. KERNER, 404 U.S. 519, 520 (PER CURIAM) (PRO-SE COMPLAINT HELD TO LESS STRINGED STANDARDS THAT FORMAL PAPERS DRAFTED BY LAWYERS).

REASON FOR GRANTING THE PETITION

N.C. LEGISLATURE WAS BARRED BY 5TH, 8TH AND 14TH AMD. U.S.C. FROM ASSEMBLING (4) CRIMINAL STATUTES INTO N.C.G.S. 14-7.1.

SINCE N.C.G.S. 14-7.1 WAS UNLAWFULLY ASSEMBLED IT MAKES THE ENHANCED SENTENCE UNCONSTITUTIONAL.

ALL N.C. HABITUAL FELON CONVICTIONS SHOULD BE VACATED, BECAUSE N.C.G.S. 14-7.1 IS PATENTLY UNCONSTITUTIONAL.
