

THE PARTICULARS ARE:

I believe that I have been discriminated against in the terms, conditions, and privileges of employment due to retaliation for the following reasons:

Work as a maintenance man for at a property managed by my employer.

On November 4, 2015, after a meeting with several employees and the property manager, I expressed my intention to file a charge of discrimination against my employer to a coworker who was present at the meeting. I filed an inquiry with the Office of Human Rights later that day. The next day, I was called into the office for a meeting with management for the company. They informed me I was being suspended with pay allegedly due to a light being left on and a door remaining locked. The suspension lasted three days and I returned to work.

Therefore, I charge Respondent with unlawful discriminatory acts in violation of the D.C. Human Rights Act of 1977, as amend, and Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended. I have not commenced any other civil, criminal, or administrative action based on the above allegations other than the instant charge.

I want this charge filed with both the EEOC and the State or local Agency, if any. I will advise the agencies if I change my address or phone number and I will cooperate fully with them in the processing of my charge in accordance with their procedures.



I believe that I have been discriminated against in the terms, conditions, and privileges of employment based on my Age (59) for the following reasons:</p>				
<p>Background</p> <p>Respondent Community Manager noticed that one light was left on and one lock was left unlocked in the Respondent's Rental Office. As a result, the Community Manager decided to change the main lock to the rental office which housed all the keys to the apartments.</p>				
<p>Disparate Treatment- Terms and Conditions- Age</p> <p>On November 4, 2015, Respondent Community Manager held a meeting where he stated that only one person would be given the new master key to the Rental Office and he designated the Porter holder of that key. The Porter in fact, was younger than I (30-35 years old), less experienced, and had only been employed with the Respondent for 3-4 years. Prior to the changing of the main lock on the Rental Office, everyone (Porter, Engineer, and I) had the master key to the Rental Office. I expressed to the Community Manager that I was not pleased with his decision and thererfore told the Porter that I planned to file a charge with OHR against the Respondent for age discrimination. Being that I was one of the two maintenance men in charge of emergency maintenance not having a master key to access the rental office after hours for my job duties. I believe that I was discriminated against based on my age because the Community Manager previously made statements that I was old and moving slowly. I also feel that I was discriminated based on my age because the Community Manager gave the master key to someone who is younger and less experienced than I.</p>				
<p>Therefore, I charge Respondent with unlawful discriminatory acts in violation of the Age Discrimination Employment Act of 1967 as amended, and the D.C. Human Rights Act of 1977, as amended. I have not commenced any other action civil, criminal or administrative, based on the above allegations, other than the instant Charge of Discrimination that has been cross-filed with the EEOC.</p>

I was hired by Respondent in June 1991, as a Maintenance Technician/Porter. I believe that I have been discriminated against in the terms, conditions, and privileges of employment and subjected to retaliation for participating in a protected activity on November 4, 2015 (filed a charge with the District Columbia ["D.C."] Office of Human Rights, #16-360- P(CN)) and November 5, 2015 (filed a second charge with the District of Columbia ["D.C."] Office of Human Rights, #16-189-P(CN)) for the following reasons:

Discharge - Retaliation

On June 27, 2016, I was called into Respondent's Community Director's office and the Chairman was present. Respondent's Chairman stated, "Jeremiah, we are going to have to let you go, you are terminated." He only gave me one word as an explanation, "Misconduct." I was given two (2) checks and a letter of termination. I contend that I was terminated as a retaliatory act for filing two (2) charges of discrimination against Respondent with OHR.

Therefore, I charge Respondent with unlawful discriminatory acts in violation of Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, and the D.C. Human Rights Act of 1977, as amended. I have not commenced any other action civil, criminal, or administrative based on the above allegations other than the instant Charge of Discrimination that has been cross-filed with the EEOC.

I want this charge filed with both the EEOC and the State or local Agency, if any. I will advise the agencies if I change my address or phone number and I will cooperate fully with them in the processing of my charge in accordance with their procedures.



Any D.C. Court may authorize the commencement or defense of any non-criminal suit, action, or proceeding, without payment to the Court.

16. 44

§ 15-712. Proceedings in forma pauperis.

(a) Any District of Columbia court may authorize the commencement, prosecution or defense of any noncriminal suit, action or proceeding, or appeal therein, without prepayment of fees and costs or security therefor, including the fees for transcripts on appeal, by a person who is unable to pay such costs or give security therefor without substantial hardship to himself or herself or his or her family, as established by affidavit or other proof satisfactory to the court.

(b) Any person who makes an affidavit as provided in subsection (a) of this section and states therein that he or she receives public assistance under the District of Columbia Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, Program on Work, Employment, and Responsibility or General Assistance for Children programs, or receives assistance under title XVI of the Social Security Act (Supplemental Security Income) (76 Stat. 197) shall be presumed eligible to proceed without prepayment of fees and costs or security therefor.


