Pursuant to Rule 39, Rules of the Supreme Court, Petitioner James Lynn Styers hereby moves for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* in the above-captioned action on the ground that he lacks sufficient funds to pay for fees and expenses.

Petitioner is incarcerated under sentence of death in the Arizona State Prison in Florence, Arizona. Mr. Styers was found indigent by the Arizona state courts in 1989 and has remained so since that time. *State v. Styers*, 865 P.2d 765 (1993). He has previously been found indigent by this Court and the lower federal courts, where counsel was appointed pursuant to 18 USC § 3599. *Styers v. Arizona*, No. 11-6674 (U.S.); *Styers v. Schriro*, No. CV-98-2244-PHX-JAT (D.Ariz.). For these reasons, Petitioner asks this Court grant this motion and allow him to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
