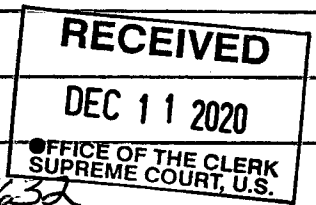

Petition For Rehearing

Now comes Petitioner, Rick Shawn, petitioning for a rehearing on his Petition For Writ Of Certiorari, claiming violations of "Due Process," "Equal Protection," and "Double Jeopardy," and "Arbitrary Unfairness". Same is submitted in good-faith, with no intent for delay nor harassment.

1. Petitioner submits, to his best understanding, having submitted substantive legal argument for his claims in his Petition For Writ Of Mandamus which propagated the petition in issue now in this Court. The rulings referenced were from this Supreme Court, the 9th Circuit U.S. Court of Appeals, and it's sister circuits, including lower state courts.
2. Petitioner submits that the usurpation of constitutional protections via state level judiciaries and law-enforcement (deputies, detectives, investigators, police and sheriffs) will and has ultimately evolved into "tyranny". The same tyranny which has led to unjustifiable deaths of civilians due to despotic mindsets that have developed from "arbitrariness" and a lack of concern in the employment of customs and practices used to generate "benevolence" in our systems of government, and the American People, as should be the norm and/or the prerequisite for all entities or people working in law-enforcement, in or with the

criminal justice system.

3. Thomas Jefferson, our third President of The United States (1743-1826), once said: "Experience hath shown, that even Under the best forms of [government] those entrusted with power have, in time, and by slow operation, perverted it into tyranny."

Petitioner asks this Supreme Court: "Did the founding fathers of the Constitution intend to negate or subvert tyranny when drafting the Constitution"?

4. Petitioner, in seeking Rehearing, also submits his "Petition" brings to light another issue of government and it's actions, as to how society is impacted. Supreme Court Justice Louis D. Brandeis (1856-1941), once said: "To declare that in the administration of criminal law the end justifies the means - to declare that the Government may commit crimes in order to secure conviction of a private criminal - would bring terrible retribution." He also said: "Crime is contagious. If the government becomes the lawbreaker, it breeds contempt for the law."

Petitioner contends unfettered customs and practices in violation of our constitution by law-enforcement, such as in Petitioner's circumstances has led to, and

contributes to the civil unrest in our nation. In Petitioner's circumstances, even now, Respondents has twice refused to accept "service" of process; (A) Petition For A Writ Of Mandamus; and (B) Petition For A Writ of Certiorari To The Supreme Court Of Nevada, failing to defend against either, violating due process and equal protection. It is contended, also, this is abject bureaucratic practice (3). Certiorari should be granted to confirm that no one is above the Constitution or Supreme Law of The Land, as it has reinforced and strengthened the fiber of this nation irregardless of the trials and tribulation with which we are faced. Conclusion

Wherefore, Petitioner prays Certiorari is granted, and the relief requested in the Petition For Writ Of Mandamus.
