

Specifically, for the safety and wellbeing of the population and staff a modified program was implemented to reduce the spread and/or exposure of the COVID19 throughout the facility. The Facility C Gym Dorm; G-Wing; Chapel #1; Chapel #2 and O-Wing East Side Tiers 1-3 have been placed on Isolation Status while B-Wing; C-Wing; E-Wing; F-Wing; O-Wing; X-Wing; Y-Wing and Z-Wing remain on Quarantine Status. Health Care request forms (CDCR7362) shall be picked up daily at the cell by Health Care staff and documented in the unit logbook. All ADA accommodations shall be adhered. Education and Re-Entry staff will issue homework packets to the cell front of impacted inmates. Unit Lieutenants shall ensure the PSR is distributed to Medical, HCAU, Housing Units and Inmate Advisory Council.</p>

I, James Joseph Lynch, Jr., Attorney for Defendant:

I am asking for funds for a transcript because I believe that there was substantial error, and I wish to do a motion for new trial to make a record the appellate attorney, and the reasons for my tactical decisions.

→ Defendant was found guilty of the lesser count of battery as a misdemeanor. There is no physical evidence as to the arson linking defendant to that crime. The last one in the house was the victim herself. Defendant had an alibi.

→ It is my professional opinion that the DDA handling the case engaged in improper tactics, objected to, which the court overruled.

The panel previously appointed Mr. Cox in this case to do some follow-up investigation, and paid for service of subpoenas.

Defendant is still claiming pauper status, the family has no more funds to pay me, \$2,000 balance owing, and nothing for the transcripts.

I was asked by the NAACP to get involved, and gave a very substantial discount to the family to fund the defense. I have been paid only \$3,000.00.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct and that this declaration was executed on 7/18/2008.



05-09-07, 1545 Hrs: I, Fire Investigator R. Moore #F008, contacted and obtained a statement from W-Dowling, Rosario in front of [REDACTED]. W-Dowling lives in a residence directly behind the Parkside Apartments and was contacted during a canvas of the area.

W-Dowling, Rosario stated the following in summary:

"I recall that on 4-21-07 at about 1730 hrs myself and my son (W-Dowling, Spencer age 10) were in our backyard at [REDACTED]. We were painting a bike with some spray paint. I heard someone running through my next door neighbors back yard ([REDACTED]) and then a gate or door slam. I recall being alarmed by this because we have had several homes on our court broken into over the past few months. I did not see the person running through the yard. I did not go out front to see if I could see who ran through the yard because I was involved with spray painting a bike wheel and could not set everything down. My son went over by the fence and then stood up on the swing set and looked over into the neighbors back yard. My son told me he saw a White Male Adult in a white shirt heading from the south side of the neighbors back yard toward the front yard (north side of property)."

06-12-07, 1500 Hrs: I, Sacramento Fire Investigator R. Moore #F008 interviewed and obtained a statement (audio recorded) from W-Karapetyn by phone. W-Karapetyn lives in unit [REDACTED] at 6 [REDACTED] Av.

W-Karapetyn stated the following in summary:

"I recall that about a week before the fire in unit [REDACTED] I accidentally received some court papers concerning the boyfriend of V-Addison. I did not know V-Addison prior to this but she told me about the problems she was having with her boyfriend (S-Borden). V-Addison also told me to watch out for her boyfriend (because of restraining order) and showed me a picture of him.

On the day of the fire myself and a friend who was staying with me at the time (W-Adams, Angela) were around the corner at a birthday party. I got a call saying my apartment was on fire. Angela and I got in my car and drove back to the Parkside Apartments. I discovered the fire was not in my apartment. I was standing out in front of the apartment with my dog and I saw mostly people I recognized as neighbors who live in the apartment complex. I recall seeing only one person who I did not recognize from the complex. This person was a BMA, 5' 8", stocky about 185 lbs wearing blue jeans and a blue T shirt. This person was just standing around acting very laid back. I am sure this person I saw is not the boyfriend of V-Addison. From the picture I was shown the boyfriend of V-Addison would have been much heavier and possibly taller. At the time of the fire, when I was standing out in front, I never saw the boyfriend of V-Addison.

I told the Fire Captain on scene about the situation with V-Addison and her estranged boyfriend and I asked if the fire was deliberately set. The Fire Captain told me that he it looked like a container or tank was thrown into the apartment by someone. The Fire Captain was the only person who told me what might have happened in apartment [REDACTED]."


