The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on October 2, 2020, and placed on the docket on October 15, 2020. The government's response is now due, after one extension, on January 11, 2021. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including February 10, 2021, within which to file a response.

This extension is necessary because the attorneys with principal responsibility for final preparation of the government's response have been heavily engaged with the press of other matters before the Court.
