COMES NOW, the Petitioner, represented by the undersigned counsel, and before this Honorable Court respectfully requests to proceed in *forma pauperis*, pursuant to Rule 39.1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States. 1. 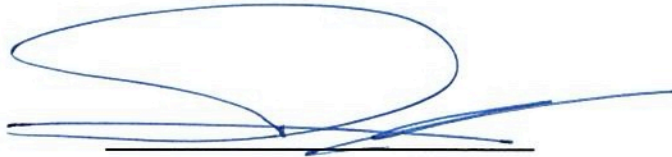
