The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on October 26, 2020, and placed on the docket on October 29, 2020. The government's response is now due, after one extension, on December 30, 2020. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including January 4, 2021, within which to file a response.
