

Attached as Exhibit F to the appendix attached to the attached petition is the Second Circuit order dated December 21, 2018, which remains effective, appointing your undersigned as counsel to petitioner pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act, 18 USC § 3006A.

WHEREFORE, and for other reasons that to the Court might seem just and proper, Petitioner's motion for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* before this Court should be granted.
