

## Re: Gurvey v. Cowan Liebowitz & Latman, PC, et al.; No. 20-623

To the Honorable Court:

This Firm represents respondents Cowan, Liebowitz & Latman, PC, and William Borchard, Midge Hyman, Baila Celedonia, and Christopher Jensen (collectively, the "Cowan Attorneys"). We write to waive a response to the petition of Amy R. Gurvey, *pro se* ("Appellant Gurvey"),<sup>1</sup> seeking a writ of certiorari from the June 23, 2020 Order of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit ("Order") transferring pro se Appellant's petition seeking writ of mandamus to the Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit.

Although the Cowan Attorneys waive a response to Gurvey's petition seeking a writ of certiorari to this Court, *pro se* Appellant Gurvey's instant petition asserts the same arguments previously asserted in her April 18, 2019 petition for writ of certiorari to the Court.<sup>2</sup> Ultimately, the Court denied Gurvey's petition, and thereafter denied a Pro Se Appellant Gurvey's request for a rehearing. *Gurvey*, 757 F. App'x 62, *cert. denied*, 140 S. Ct. 161, 205 L. Ed. 2d 52 (2019), *reh'g denied*, No. 18-8930, 2019 WL 6257536 (U.S. Nov. 25, 2019).

Therefore, the Cowan Attorneys respectfully waive a response to pro se Appellant
