

**MEMORANDUM ORDER
(Denying Request for Bond)**

By Memorandum Opinion and Order entered on March 30, 2019, the Court dismissed this action without prejudice. On April 8, 2019, the Court received a "NOTICE OF APPEAL/BOND." (ECF No. 6.) The Court transmitted the Notice of Appeal to the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit and on June 6, 2019, the Fourth Circuit dismissed Plaintiff's appeal. (ECF No. 8.)

In his request for bond, Plaintiff complains of various conditions of his confinement and requests that the Court grant him bond. Plaintiff fails to identify a procedural vehicle that would allow this Court to release Plaintiff on bond when he is in state custody. Accordingly, Plaintiff's request for bond (ECF No. 6) is DENIED. No further action will be taken in this closed case.
