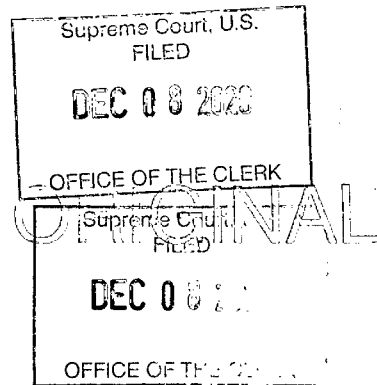

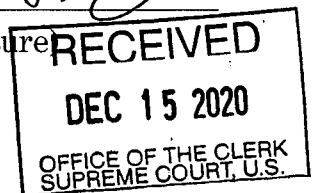

**AFFIDAVIT OR DECLARATION

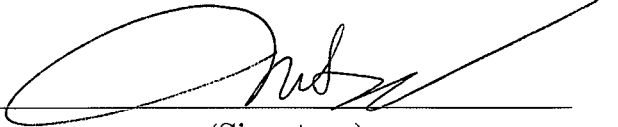
