**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN
FORMA PAUPERIS**

The Petitioner, SHUSTA GUMBS, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, hereby moves this Court for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

1. A judge of the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia determined Mr. Gumbs to be indigent pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A.
