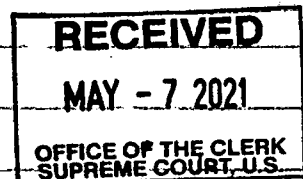

until March 21, 2021.

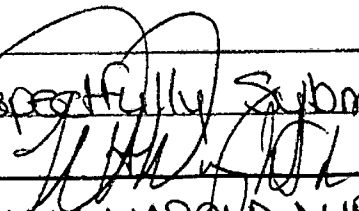
3.) Due to the Court late notice, order
