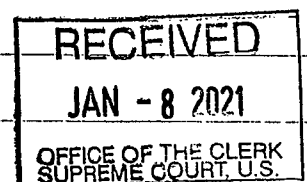

Brief to his Pet. For A Writ of Certiorari on New

On Dec. 29, 2020, the ABC news Affiliate,
news channel 15, ran a one hour "Special Report"
in Primetime, at 7pm called, "FULL DISCLOSURE"
uncovering Brady List Violations, Police and
AZ Prosecutor's MISCONDUCT related to Exculpatory
Evidence.

In this news investigational report, the Maricopa



County Attorney, Allister Adel, gave an interview and was asked -On the Record- About the Process For BRADY LISTS and Exculpatory Evidence given to defendant's Pre-Trial.

Ms. Adel stated, Quote "Any Evidence, or Brady list are NOT given to a defense or defendant UNLESS A Judge Finds Good Cause and ORDERS those materials to be handed over to the Defense in prosecution cases." end Quote

The ABC reporter put this statement on the TV screen, and spelled it out "Word For Word" as the Maricopa County Attorney made the statement.

The ABC News Bureau knew that this was "UNCONSTITUTIONAL" and a Violation of BRADY v Maryland, (373 U.S. 83 S.Ct. 1963), and violated the Due Process Clause of U.S. Constitution and violated the 6th Amendment.

After report came out, this Maricopa County Attorney, Allister Adel, was Forced to make another "Public Statement" on the record and it was put on this TV special report, aired Dec. 29, 2020.

County Attorney Adel Admitted that she MISUNDERSTOOD THE LAW in regards to Exculpatory Evidence and that she was IN ERROR! (Misconduct By Entire Prosecutor's

And then Unlawfully Sentenced to 17 years Flat Prison without ever Providing my BRADY EVIDENCE (10) Ten Ct. proceedings Hidden (see Appendix G) all Ct. transcripts Denied to Mr. Waldrep on 21 ch filled "Motions To Compel Production of Records"
