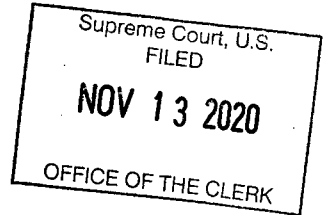

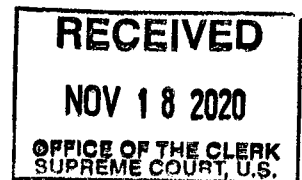

**CONSTITUTIONAL AND STATUTORY PROVISIONS INVOLVED**

Overall, a mandate has the same effect AS A LAW.

**Petition writ of Certiorari**

A party who wants the Supreme Court to review a decision of a federal or state court. A petition is printed in booklet format and 40 copies are filed with the court.

**Affidavit:** A sworn, written statement made under oath, affirming that all information is true.

**Complaint:** A written statement filed by the plaintiff that opens a case, identifies the plaintiff's claims and states what relief the plaintiff is seeking.

**Summary Judgment motion:** A motion requesting the court to rule on facts that are not in dispute so rule in one party's favor without trial.

**Notice of Appeal:** A document filed that informs the court that a judgment or order is being appealed for the federal circuit. The filing of a notice of appeal begins the appeal process and must be accompanied by a certificate of service.

**Plaintiff:** The person who files the complaint in a civil lawsuit.

**Pro Se:** A term that refers to an individual who presents their own case without an attorney.

**Lack of Jurisdiction:** No authorities will entertain your case.

**Non-injunction:** A person can start and continue legal actions.

**Notice of Appearance:** A document filed by an attorney at the U.S. Dept. of Justice identifying who will be representing the U.S. in a case. Once an appearance is filed, those litigants must serve all future filings on the attorney listed on notice of appearance.

**Certificate of Service Rule:** All documents filed after the complaint must include a certificate of service stating that you "served" a copy of the document on the attorney representing the U.S. and on other parties.

**Informal Briefing Schedule:** Under local rule 34b, the court uses an informal briefing schedule in cases involving those litigants to permit the court to consider the merits without requiring the pro se litigant to comply with formal briefing requirements.

**En Banc in Law:** An en banc session is a session in which a case is heard before all the judges of a court rather than by one judge or a panel of judges selected from them. Rule # Fed. Cir. #35.

**Discrimination in Services and Public Functions:** If you're treated unfairly by a public sector organization or public authorities.

**Petition:** A request made for something desired, especially a respectful or humble request as to a superior or to one of those in authority. A document addressed to some official and signed by numerous individuals.
