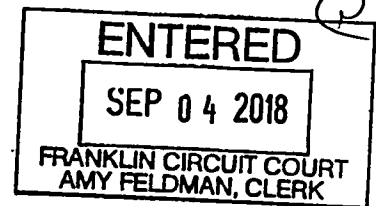
WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Petitioners respectfully request that they be permitted to proceed in this action *in forma pauperis*.
