Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on January 4, 2021. The government's response is now due, after one extension, on April 19, 2021. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including May 10, 2021, within which to file a response.

This extension is necessary because the attorneys with principal responsibility for preparation of the government's response have been heavily engaged with the press of previously assigned matters with proximate due dates. The government has agreed not to seek a further extension of its time to respond.
