This cause came before the court, Honorable James J. Brady, District Judge, presiding, and the jury having rendered its verdict,

IT IS ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED that there be judgment entered herein in favor of plaintiff, John Poullard, and against defendants, Joseph Turner, Lonnie Edmonds, Michael Levatino, and Don Thames, for \$750,000.00 in compensatory damages plus interest and costs according to law.


