MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*

Petitioner, Maurice Burks, respectfully moves this Court to grant him leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*. In support thereof, Mr. Burks shows:

1. Mr. Burks was charged by indictment in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Tennessee with engaging in a RICO conspiracy (Count One); conspiracy to distribute controlled substances (Count Two); possessed ammunition as a convicted felon (Count Ten); murdered Malcolm Wright in the aid of racketeering (Count Eleven); brandished and discharged a firearm during and in relation to a crime of violence (Count Thirteen); and caused Malcolm Wright's death through the use and carrying of a firearm (Count Fourteen). A United States Magistrate Judge found Mr. Burks to be indigent and appointed undersigned counsel pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006(A).

2. Mr. Burks was allowed to proceed *in forma pauperis* on appeal to the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit.

3. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, Mr. Burks should be allowed to proceed *in forma pauperis* in this Court.

WHEREFORE, Mr. Burks respectfully requests that this Court:

1. Grant him leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*; and
2. Grant such other relief as this Court deems just.
