**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED
IN FORMA PAUPERIS**

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, Petitioner Stanley Joseph Thompson respectfully files this Motion for Leave to Proceed In Forma Pauperis, showing the Court as follows:
