Comes the Petitioner, Tyslen Baker, by counsel, and moves the Court for leave to proceed In Forma Pauperis in this action, and in support of that request, states as follows:

1. Petitioner Tyslen Baker, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, seeks leave to proceed In Forma Pauperis.

2. This matter arises out of a criminal prosecution of Tyslen Baker in the United States v. Tyslen J. Baker, Case Number 4:17-CR-00007-JHM, filed in the United States District Court for the Western District of Kentucky. In the District Court matter, Petitioner was appointed counsel pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act of 1964, 18 USC §3006. See Exhibit A.
