MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, Petitioner requests leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*, and to file the attached Petition for Writ of Certiorari without prepayment of fees.

1.
