Dear Mr. Harris:

I am counsel for Respondent General Electric Co. (“GE”) in the above-captioned matter. The petition for a writ of certiorari in this case was docketed on November 25, 2020. The Court called for a response to the petition on December 30, 2020. The response to the petition is currently due on January 29, 2021. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, GE respectfully requests that the time for filing a response be extended by thirty days, up to and including March 1, 2020 (because thirty days from January 29 is February 28, a Sunday).

GE makes this request in light of counsel’s other pending professional obligations, including responsive pleadings due in three cases on January 25, 2021 (*Vuksanovich v. Airbus Group HQ, Inc., et al.*, No. 1:20-cv-11857 (D. Mass.); *Salvatore v. Airbus Group HQ, Inc., et al.*, No. 1:20-cv-11879 (D. Mass.); and *Wong v. Carnival Corporation & plc*, No. 2:20-cv-04727 (C.D. Cal.)), and a fourth responsive pleading due on January 27, 2021 (*Esquivel v. Airbus Americas, Inc.*, No. 20-cv-07525 (N.D. Ill.)). The requested extension would also permit GE to coordinate its submission with that of Respondent Tokyo Electric Power Co. Holdings, Inc., which is likewise seeking a thirty-day extension of time to file its response to the petition.
