

- 1) This court ruled in Houston v. Lack 101 L.Ed 2d 245, 246 (1988) that ("[Petitions for Rehearing] by prisoners who represent themselves are to be considered filed for the purposes of [rule 44] at the moment such [petitions] are delivered to prison authorities for forwarding to the court.clerk.) (Emphasis added)
- 2) As shown in Exhibit A, the petition was delivered to prison authorities on the 19th of May, 2021; 2 days prior to the filing deadline.
- 3) The prison mailroom did not Stamp or mail the petition till the 24th of May, 2021; 3 days AFTER the deadline.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated herein, petitioner maintains that the petition WAS filed timely, and moves the clerk of this court to file his petition out of time.


