Antoine Deshawn Barnes has filed a "Petition for Writ of Habeas Per Senate Bill 10 Release on O.R," in which Barnes asks this court to release him on his own recognizance in Monterey County Superior Court criminal proceedings. Barnes provides no authority for his request, and we know of none. Accordingly, his request is denied.

To the extent that Barnes wishes for this court to direct the state court to release him on his own recognizance, Barnes has not demonstrated that this case warrants the intervention of this court by means of the extraordinary remedy of mandamus. *See Bauman v. U.S. Dist. Court*, 557 F.2d 650 (9th Cir. 1977); *see also Demos v. U.S. Dist. Court*, 925 F.2d 1160, 1161 (9th Cir. 1991) ("[T]his court

lacks jurisdiction to issue a writ of mandamus to a state court.”). Accordingly, the petition is denied.
