A response in this death penalty case is due May 7, 2021. Respondent respectfully requests a thirty-day extension of the present deadline, up to and including June 6, 2021. This is Respondent's first request for an extension in this case. The extension request is not sought for an improper purpose, including harassment or unnecessary delay. Rather, the undersigned requires additional time due to the demands of supervising multiple attorneys with capital caseloads and the undersigned's own work in such cases. This includes recent time spent on the capital cases of *Brown v. Davis*, No. 3:19-cv-02301-L-BN (N.D. Tex.), *Johnson v. Davis*, No. 3:19-cv-02310-E (N.D.
