1. WHETHER THE PRESENTMENT OF FALSE AND MISLEADING TESTIMONY AND EVIDENCE TO THE GRAND JURY DENIES THE PETITIONER DUE PROCESS, AS IT CONSTITUTES TO BE A FUNDAMENTAL MISCALLAGE OF JUSTICE.

4. WHETHER APPELLATE COUNSELS FROM THE SECOND, THIRD, AND FOURTH APPELLATE DISTRICTS WERE INEFFECTIVE FOR FAILING TO FILE AN MERITS BRIEF.
5. WHETHER THE STATE COURT ERRED IN ALLOWING THE STATE TO VIOLATE THE NOTICE REQUIREMENT IN PUNITING THE PETITIONER ON NOTICE IT WAS SEEKING EXTENDED TERM SENTENCING AFTER THE PETITIONER'S BENCH TRIAL.
6. WHETHER THE STATE COURT ERRED IN ALLOWING THE STATE TO TRY THE PETITIONER FIRST ON COUNT II; ARMED HABITUAL CRIMINAL, WITHOUT AN UNDERLYING OFFENSE.
