No motion for rehearing or reinstatement will be entertained by the Court.

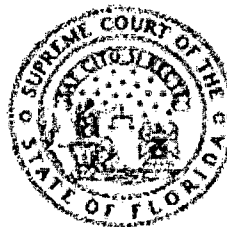
