

O R D E R

The petitioner appeals the denial of his petition under 28 U.S.C. § 2254 for a writ of habeas corpus. The district court appointed Attorney Matthew G. Borgula under the Criminal Justice Act (CJA), 18 U.S.C. § 3006A(a)(2)(B), to represent the petitioner in the district court proceedings. The petitioner moves for leave to proceed on appeal *in forma pauperis* and for the continued appointment of Attorney Borgula as appellate counsel. The appointment of CJA counsel generally extends through an appeal, and a person for whom CJA counsel is appointed under § 3006A generally may appeal without prepayment of fees. *See* § 3006A(c) and (d)(7).

Therefore, the clerk extends the appointment of CJA counsel for purposes of this appeal.
