QUESTION(S) PRESENTED

The 1st Amendment of the United States Constitution does allow me to speak out and confront the Mgmt of Rental Property, when I am mistreated and ignored because they would not do anything for me or in my behalf for being called a retard by a non-resident who knew I had Epilepsy. I paid Rent to the Mgmt at Greysolon Plaza and was a paying renter. He paid no rent. He was a non-resident not a renter. I have Epilepsy. I am not Retarded.

I was entitled to be treated fairly, as was speaking to another person who witnesses this injustice when I was called a retard and the Mgmt heard it on the 12th floor at about 11:30 AM on Sept. 27th of 2018. I was minding my own business and not bothering anyone at all.

I eventually got evicted unjustly and unconstitutionally because I spoke out against the Mgmt to the Northern Min. Director of Gov. Sherman and Assoc. I received Federal help for Federally assisted Rental Housing Sherman Assoc. Received Federal Money to help house me but made me homeless still have no permanent address. Although disabled when I was allegedly evicted I found myself paying and had to pay \$2,600 Rent for 2 months at a nearby hotel which is now being torn down I have proof of the name of the hotel is Lake Walk Inn in Duluth Min its address was 333 East Superior St. Duluth, Min. 55802

I was mistreated and unconstitutionally kicked out of my apt on Jan 14th, 2019 I had to leave other wise I would be arrested, and put in jail for trespassing.

My Mom's things were stolen when damaged my Grandmother's things were stolen my property was damaged or stolen and a small stamp collection was stolen plus other collectibles from many years ago. My Religious and Family mementoes or artifacts were stolen. Some of my Furniture damaged.
