I have Epilepsy. I am not retarded.

I was Entitled to be treated fairly, I was speaking to another person who witnessed this injustice when I was called a retard and the Mgmt. Heard it on the 12th floor at about 11:30 AM on Sept. 27th 2018. I was running my own Business and not bothering anyone at all.

I eventually got Evicted unfairly and unconstitutionally because I spoke out against the Mgmt. to the Northern MN. Director of Mr. Sherman and assoc. I Received Federal help for Federally assisted Rental Housing. Sherman & assoc. Received Federal Money to help House me but made me homeless still have no permanent address. Although I called when I was allegedly evicted & found myself Paying a Rent of \$2000 Rent for 2 months at a Motel which is not being run down & have proof. The Name of the Motel is Lake Walk Inn in Duluth, MN. its address was 333 East Superior St. Duluth, MN. 55802

I was mistreated and unconstitutionally kicked out of my apt on Jan 14th, 2019 I had to leave other wise I would be arrested, and put in jail for trespassing.

My Mom's things were stolen damaged my Grandmother things were stolen my proper tools were damaged or stolen and a small stony collection was stolen plus other Collectables from Many years ago. My Religious and Family momentos or artifacts were stolen. Some of my Furniture Damaged.
