Dear Mr. Harris:

On April 26, 2021, the Court granted the petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case. The government's brief as petitioner is currently due on June 10, 2021.

Because of scheduling difficulties and the press of other matters before the Court, the parties respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a 22-day extension of time, to and including July 2, 2021, within which to file the government's brief; and an 11-day extension of time, to and including August 13, 2021, within which to file the respondents' brief. If those extensions are granted, the reply brief would be due on September 13, 2021 (a Monday).

The parties have agreed on the schedule above, which is necessary to accommodate to the litigation schedules of counsel.
