**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN
FORMA PAUPERIS**

The Petitioner, MARTEZ HOWARD, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, hereby moves this Court for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

1. Mr. Howard was determined to be indigent pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, by a judge of the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia. Undersigned counsel was appointed to represent Mr. Howard in the district court and on appeal before the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit.
