Dear Mr. Harris:

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Respondents Speed, Boyer, Langston, Muse, Chapman, Rice, Brooks and Banks County, Georgia respectfully move for an extension of time for filing their response to Appellant Greenway's Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the referenced case, until February 4, 2021.

The Petition for Writ of Certiorari was docketed on December 22, 2020. The current due date for the response is January 21, 2021, and the requested extension is 14 days.

Counsel for Defendant seeks the extension due primarily to the recent holidays and a heavy litigation work load. Depositions and an appellate brief will consume most of the week of January 10. The week of January 18 features a federal holiday, and that week will be largely consumed by a summary judgment argument and a second federal appellate brief in a wrongful death case that falls due on January 20, 2021.

Counsel is authorized to state that Petitioner, through his counsel, consents to this extension.


