
MOTION TO DELAY DISTRIBUTION OF PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

Petitioner David E. Henry, by and through his undersigned counsel, hereby requests that distribution of his Petition for Writ of Certiorari, filed herein on December 21, 2020, be postponed by sixty (60) days, that is, until June 12, 2021. Respondent Castle Medical Center filed its Brief for the Respondent in Opposition on March 30, 2021, and therefore, pursuant to the Rules of the Supreme Court Rule 15.5, the deadline to distribute the Petition, the Brief, and any Reply to the Court for its consideration is April 13, 2021. Effectively, April 13, 2021 is the deadline for Petitioner to file his Reply Brief, pursuant to Rule 15.6.

Petitioner seeks postponement of the distribution date in order to be able to file a reply to Respondent's brief in opposition to the petition before the documents are distributed to the Court. Petitioner's counsel need additional time to prepare a reply on behalf of Petitioner because their current workload does not allow sufficient time to do so by the deadline of April 13, 2021 and their workflow has been disrupted by difficulties related to the present public health emergency. Therefore, pursuant to the Rules of the Supreme Court Rules 21 and the Court's order dated March 19, 2020 (589 U.S.), Petitioner respectfully moves for delay of the distribution date of his Petition and accompanying documents by 60 days.

The undersigned asked counsel for Respondent Castle Medical Center whether they opposed this request and they stated that they took no position.
