I represent Petitioner Trinell King in the above-captioned case. Pursuant to the Court's order of March 19, 2020, addressing the ongoing public health concerns relating to COVID-19, I request a 7-day delay of the distribution of the petition for a writ of certiorari in this case. The brief in opposition was filed on March 3, 2021, and the petition is currently scheduled to be distributed on March 22, 2021. A 7-day delay would cause the petition being scheduled for distribution on March 29, 2021.
